Meeting Topic(s): the EOP Committee and AP will provide feedback and input on a research project the Council is collaborating on with a research team from Rutgers University. The project is developing forecast models to predict short-term (1-10 years) climate-induced distribution changes for four economically important Mid and South Atlantic managed species (summer flounder, spiny dogfish, *Illex* squid, and gray triggerfish). A forecast model for summer flounder has been developed and the Committee and AP will provide feedback on the model outputs and their potential utility and offer input on future project direction and next steps.
