Background

- October 2020 Council meting E.O. 13921
 - List of recommendations
 - "Initiate a framework to allow golden tilefish specifications to be set for more than 3 years"
 - 2021 Council Proposed Actions and Deliverables
 - Initiate golden tilefish multi-year specifications framework (E.O. 13921 recommendation)

Multi-Year Specifications Framework - What's in it?

- Considers measures to revise the specifications process
- Minor modifications to the management system – process related
 - Duration for setting multi-year management measures
 - The timing of the fishing year
- Set new specifications for 2023-2024

1) Multi-Year Specifications

- Golden tilefish management specifications set for up to 3 years
- Modify process to simply change the number of years (time period) for which those measures could be set so they match Northeast Regional Coordinating Council (NRCC) stock assessment schedule

1) Multi-Year Specifications

- Alternative 1 (5.1.1): No Action/Status Quo
- Alternative 2 (5.1.2): Specifications to be set for maximum number of years needed to be consistent with the Northeast Regional Coordinating Council (NRCC)-approved stock assessment schedule

1) Multi-Year Specifications

None of the multi-year specification alternatives are expected to impact the prosecution of the golden tilefish fishery, including landings levels, distribution of fishing effort, or fishing methods and practices

2) Fishing Year Timing

□ Fishing year is November 1 – October 31

Modify process to simply change how the fishing year timing is set

2) Fishing Year Timing

- Alternative 1 (5.2.1): No Action/Status Quo
- Alternative 2 (5.2.1 5.2.2): The golden tilefish fishing year is the 12-month period beginning with January 1, annually
 - Therefore, the fishing year is January 1 December
 31

- 2) Fishing Year Timing
- Under Alternative 2
 - Fishing year = calendar year
 - Matches fishing year with cost recovery calculations
 - Matches stock assessment results/projections which are based on calendar year

2) Fishing Year Timing

None of the fishing year timing alternatives are expected to impact the prosecution of the golden tilefish fishery, including landings levels, distribution of fishing effort, or fishing methods and practices

- **3**) 2023-2024 Specifications
- 2021-2022 (interim) multi-year specifications cycle
- Typically, set/review specs in early Spring
- Slight change in timing to conduct specs process

■ 3) 2023-2024 Specifications

- NRCC stock assessment process/schedule
 - Management track assessment update June 2021
 - Review 2022 and set 2023-2024
 - Research track stock assessment June 2024
 - Set 2025-2026-2027

■ 3) 2023-2024 Specifications

□ Findings and recommendations will be presented to Council (August 2021)

- 3) 2023-2024 Specifications
- To facilitate this transition:
 - Modify 2022 specs/FY
 - Currently from Nov 1, 2021 Oct 31, 2022, to
 - Nov 1, 2021 Dec 31, 2022 (One-time only adjustment)
- □ Then, set specs for
 - 2023: Jan 1, 2023 Dec 31, 2023; and
 - 2024: Jan 1, 2024 Dec 31, 2024
